Two of Burgundy's greatest names – Jacques Seysses, founder of Domaine Dujac, and Aubert de Villaine, co-owner of Domaine de la Romanée-Conti – are the partners behind this pioneering property in Provence, northeast of Marseille and due east of Aix-en-Provence. Over the years, they have transformed this stunning 46-hectare site into one of the top wine estates in Southern France.

THE WINE

Harvest Notes

- Grapes harvested at night so they are cool when arrive at winery
- Pressed after a few hours of skin contact
- Fermented at low temperature until dry

Winemaker's Notes

Pale pink color. The wine has a bouquet of strawberries and white flowers with hints of vanilla. It has the harmony and elegance that has earned world-wide appreciation of the rosés of Provence. Triennes rosé is the perfect accompaniment to a sunny summer afternoon.

Technical Information

- Primarily Cinsault grapes, blended with Grenache, Syrah and Merlot
- Alcohol: 13%

90 Points - Vinous, June, 2020

Translucent onion skin. Orange zest, persimmon, red berries and a subtle floral nuance on the fragrant nose. Concentrated but lithe and seemingly weightless, offering tangy red currant, strawberry and blood orange flavors that pick up a spicy nuance on the back half. Finishes brisk and tight, with repeating spiciness and a sneaky floral quality. This wine has the depth of flavor to handle full-flavored foods,

but there's no excess fat here, either. A solid value. 2020 – 2022
